



Weekly SEN Curriculum Plan

Day	Focus Area	SEN-Adapted Activities
Monday	Communication & Social Interaction	Small group circle time using a visual timetable, Makaton greetings, turn-taking games, role play with familiar objects, naming and recognising emotions using visual supports
Tuesday	Physical Development	Fine motor: threading beads, playdough, peg boards, finger painting Gross motor: obstacle courses, balance beams, climbing, movement and coordination games
Wednesday	Early Literacy & Mathematics	Tactile letter tracing (sand, foam), interactive storytelling with props, counting everyday objects, sorting by colour, size, or shape
Thursday	Understanding the World	Sensory exploration (sand, water, natural materials), nature walks, cause-and-effect toys, exploring familiar routines, environments, and community awareness
Friday	Expressive Arts & Emotional Development	Music and movement, sensory art (clay, paint, collage), social stories focusing on emotions, sharing, routines, and role play

This weekly plan is flexible and tailored to meet each child's individual needs. Activities are adapted using visual supports, sensory resources, and adult scaffolding to ensure all children can fully access learning. The plan is reviewed regularly through ongoing observation, assessment, and close partnership with parents and external professionals.
